

Homework Format

1. Homework Header

The homework should have a header in the top of the first page like this:

Howework N

SID: ###

Name: (First_name) (Last_name)

KFUPM ID

Attempted: X of Y

Notes:

1. Write the homework number, N. For example, **Homework 1**
2. SID is a three-digit Section-ID number, which is assigned to you by the instructor (See the Blackboard/Course Content).
3. Print your first and last names (all uppercase letters) and write KFUPM ID.
4. Attempted X indicates how many exercises you have attempted, and Y is the total number of exercises.
5. Wrong or inaccurate formatting will result in a deduction of the total score.
6. The homework should be submitted online in a PDF file. The file name should be in this form: **hwN.SID###.pdf**, where N is the homework number and ## is your CSN (e.g. **hw1.SID499.pdf**).
7. Make sure to verify your submission (Download the pdf file after submission and verify it).

2. Question Header

Each question or exercise has its own header with a unique serial number. Write your answer under the header. The question header format is as follows:

Q# Reference/Sec#, Exer # (parts)

Notes:

1. **Q#** is the serial number for the questions, taken from the order of the exercise as listed in each homework assignment. If you solve the exercises in different order, make sure you sort them according to the order given on the Assignments page to maintain correct numbering.
2. The exercises are from the textbook, by Rose. **Sec** is the book section or chapter number, and **Exer #** is the exercise number. An example of a header could be like this:

Q1 Forouzan/Ch1, Exer 18(a,d)
